1. CARBON NEUTRAL INFORMATION

Description of certification

This certification covers the Australian business operations of In Hearts Wake Pty Limited, ABN 46 159 378 088.

In Hearts Wake has followed the Climate Active Carbon Neutral Standard for Organisations in the data collection and preparations of this report and used guiding Greenhouse Gas Protocol principles of; relevance, completeness, consistency, transparency and accuracy in the development of any new methodologies for this Small Organisation Portfolio.

Organisation description

In Hearts Wake are a band from Byron Bay, Australia, creating conscious heavy music committed to Climate Action in every way possible. Their power and purpose is to incite widespread positive action, breaking new ground in order to tackle the most pressing crises on the planet today.

We recognise our responsibility as artists to understand, quantify and reduce the emissions attributed to the creation, production and touring of our work. Becoming Carbon Neutral under the Climate Active certification is an important step forward for our band and the music industry.

As much as we enjoy playing music on the road, we also share a deep love for the natural world and realise the vital balance it brings us off the road. Understanding it's great importance is a reflection of our vision, values, and purpose to protect it. As artists we recognise that the future of our band is totally reliant on the health of our planet.

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Greenhouse gas emissions considered include carbon dioxide (CO2), methane (CH4), nitrous oxide (N20), hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs), perfluorocarbons (PFCs), sulphur hexafluoride (SF6) and nitrogen trifluoride (NF3).

In Hearts Wake are considered a small organization certification, which is based on the standard Climate Active small organization emissions boundary with the inclusion of additional emissions fields which attribute to no more than 5% of the total annual footprint.

Non-quantified sources

- Water has been non quantified because the information is difficult to gather relative to the estimated size of the emissions.
- ICT Equipment and Services have been non quantified because it is restricted to a very small number of laptop computers, phones and small copier / printer, and is therefore immaterial, and can be considered small in relation to stationary energy, fuel, and electricity.

Excluded sources (outside of certification boundary)

This organization makes no use of the following item categories Refrigerants, Paper, Carbon Neutral Products and Services, for this reason these emissions sources have been excluded from the In Hearts Wake boundary as they were determined immaterial and therefore not relevant.

The following guiding questions guided this exclusion process.

 Is the emission source deemed one of high-risk to In Hearts Wake?

Emissions sources are deemed to be high risk if there is a high perceived risk to In Hearts Wake reputation because of the emissions source (for example, highly visible impact sources such as marketing materials). Criteria were based on In Hearts Wake materiality assessments and will continue to be revisited each year.

2. Is the emission source of value to the event stakeholders?

High value emissions sources are those that may align with values of stakeholders, for example reducing waste from events may be particularly important to some even though the associated emissions are relatively small. The assessment of each emissions source against this criterion was based on the judgement of the band management team and Climate Active Registered Consultant working on this project.

3. Is the combined impact of the emission source significant in quantitative size?

The relative contribution of each emissions source to the footprint of the band overall was based on the inventories of each previously measured event. The significance of each emissions source in terms of size was based on this assessment.

3. EMISSIONS SUMMARY

Emissions Reduction Strategy

Several emissions reduction activities will be undertaken during the subsequent, and future reporting periods by In Hearts Wake.

Where possible the individually quantified emissions will annually be calculated and reported upon through Public Disclosure Statements.

In Hearts Wake will aim to widely promote the carbon neutral certification in 2021 with the aim of engaging partners, patrons, suppliers, and venue owners/operators.

Planned emissions reduction activities fall into the following categories:

- · Energy efficiency and renewable energy
- Waste reduction and recycling
- Low emissions transport
- Sustainable supply chain
- Measurement, marketing, and engagement.

Key strategies include:

- Encouraging partner venues to consider renewable energy purchasing.
- Reducing Air Travel where possible.
- Reducing waste by mandating the use of compostable or recyclable materials by food trucks, implementing ways to educate attendees to use the correct bins and to minimise their waste by bringing their own refillable water bottles.
- Facilitating lower emissions forms of travel for artists, attendees and staff including public transport, city bikes, more bike parking and utilising fuel-efficient vehicles where possible for hired vehicles and freight services.
- Seeking ways to reduce printed materials, including ticketing and day bills, by creating electronic programs, re-using day bills and engaging with suppliers.



- Seeking to re-purpose old sets and props wherever possible through post-event sales and donation, rather than sending to landfill
- Aiming to re-use as many items as possible including t-shirts, fence wrap, signage etc. to avoid sending to landfill.
- Removing dates from as many generic branded items as possible, to facilitate re-use in future years.
- Where possible, carbon neutral products or services will be sourced.
