

#### 1. Carbon neutral information

#### 1A. Introduction

The 2019 Banksia Awards is to be held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of December at the Hyatt Regency, Sydney. The event brings together people from various industries within Australia to celebrate successes made in sustainability. The Banksia awards have recognised over 450 winners and have received over 5000 entries in this time. The event not only celebrates these successes but acts as a central event to inspire, celebrate, promote collaboration and ultimately how Australia can be more sustainable into the future.

The carbon inventory associated with the event has been prepared based on the National Carbon Offset Standard (NCOS), The GHG Protocol: A Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (Revised Edition) and Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard published by the World Resource Institute (WRI) and World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD) and with International Standards Organisation ISO 14064-1:2006 Greenhouse gases - Part 1: Specification with guidance at the organisation level for quantification and reporting of greenhouse gas emissions and removals.

Greenhouse gases considered are the seven main Greenhouse Gases (GHGs) that contribute to climate change, as covered by the Kyoto Protocol and the Greenhouse Gas Protocol: carbon dioxide (CO2), methane (CH4), nitrous oxide N2O), hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs), perfluorocarbons (PFCs), sulphur hexafluoride (SF6) and nitrogen trifluoride (NF3).

Activities identified as being under the financial control of the responsible entity occurring as a consequence of the event have been included in the event emissions boundary. Scope 3 emissions have been considered in accordance with the standard.

#### 2. Emissions reduction measures

Banksia as a sustainability focused foundation have made measures to reduce emissions when organising the event. Throughout organising the event Banksia continues to focus on sustainability with efforts to maximise use of digital marketing and engagement, reducing paper usage and minimising total waste. As well as focusing on telecommunications to reduce unnecessary event preparation travel.
