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## 2. CERTIFICATION INFORMATION

### Description of organisation certification

This organisation certification is for the business operations of Floating Solutions Consulting Pty Ltd, ABN 15 634 237 139, as an organisation going carbon neutral under the 'Climate Active Carbon Neutral Certification Standard for Organisations'. Floating Solutions Consulting's services are outside the scope of this certification. This report includes an overview of Floating Solutions Consulting Pty Ltd's greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reduction strategy as well as a description of the GHG emissions boundaries.

This Public Disclosure Statement includes information for FY2024-25 reporting period.

### Organisation description

Established in 2017, Floating Solutions Consulting Pty Ltd (FSC) is a privately owned Australian business in the maritime industry. FSC is a leading hull structures integrity management specialist providing independent technical, strategic, and commercial advice and support to clients across the Energy, Commercial and Defence sectors to optimise the in-service performance and sustainment of hull structures.

Within this certification, all relevant emissions under Floating Solutions Consulting Pty Ltd (ABN 15 634 237 139) have been accounted for, including international-related emissions associated with working from home by offshore staff. The boundary encompasses the operational emissions associated with the following related bodies corporate:

Floating Solutions Consulting Pty Ltd is located at 191 St Georges Terrace, Perth, Western Australia.

## 3.EMISSIONS BOUNDARY

This is a small organisation certification, which uses the standard Climate Active small organisation emissions boundary.

## 4. EMISSIONS REDUCTIONS

### Emissions reduction strategy

As FSC is a consultancy, we consume very little in regard to materials, electricity and other services. While there is still potential for improvement (such as increasing the use of renewable electricity for our employees' home offices and co-working spaces), we use the Climate Active process to identify emissions reduction opportunities and guide continuous improvement. Since commencing Climate Active certification, FSC has continued to implement emissions reduction initiatives across its operations as outlined in the Emissions reductions actions section below.

FSC has achieved carbon neutrality for its operations dating back to the company's establishment in September 2017. We remain committed to continually improving our environmental performance by reducing carbon emissions where practicable and offsetting residual emissions to maintain our Climate Active carbon neutral certification.

Our goal is to maintain organisational emissions below 2 t CO<sub>2</sub>-e per year per FTE through to 2030, using FY2021 as the baseline year. The emissions intensity in the baseline year was 1.75 t CO<sub>2</sub>-e per FTE. Progress against this target is reviewed annually through the Climate Active certification process.

To achieve this target, FSC will continue to:

- Transition to a co-working space with carbon neutral status or with GreenPower-accredited electricity supply. This will reduce our office-related electricity emissions by 100%.
- Implement a procurement policy in place that encourages the use of carbon-neutral products and services, with a target for at least 50% of our professional service suppliers to be carbon neutral by January 1st 2028.
- Encourage climate literacy within our team to enable team members to make more informed decisions on their personal emissions impact.
- Purchase energy-efficiency office equipment wherever practicable.
- Prioritise sustainability-related projects through our business development activities
- Explore projects and partnerships that support sustainability and renewable energy
- Support the energy transition by helping existing oil and gas infrastructure operate as safely and efficiently as possible - while aligning with the UN, IEA, and IPCC position of not supporting any new oil and gas projects approved after 1 January 2021.

## Emissions reduction actions

Since commencing Climate Active certification, FSC has continued to implement emissions reduction initiatives across its operations and review opportunities for continuous improvement.

Completed and ongoing actions include:

- **Member of 1% for the Planet (FY2025).** FSC became a member of 1% for the Planet, committing to donate at least 1% of annual sales to approved environmental organisations. This supports organisations aligned with FSC's sustainability objectives and provides a clear, recognised framework for environmental giving.
- **Shared co-working space and flexible working arrangements (ongoing).** FSC continues to operate from a shared co-working space and maintain flexible working arrangements. Optimising the use of office space, and reducing commuting-related emissions. The co-working space is located in a 5-star NABERS-rated building supplied with 16% renewable electricity.
- **Achieving carbon neutrality since the company's establishment in 2017.** FSC has offset its historical emissions dating back to September 2017 in 2023. From 2017 to 2022, FSC self-declared its emissions and offsets. The organisation achieved Climate Active certification in FY2023 and maintained carbon neutrality in subsequent reporting years.
- **Partnering with Carbon Positive Australia** to offset residual emissions through native reforestation projects that restore degraded land across Australia.

## Co-benefits

This section provides a brief description of the carbon offsets purchased and retired for Floating Solutions Consulting Pty Ltd's carbon neutral claim.

### Max Water Reforestation 1

This project relates to 100 per cent of the total amount of offsets purchased and retired for this reporting period. Located in the Great Southern region of Western Australia, the project involves 170 hectares of permanent mallee eucalypt plantings, established in 2012 and 2013 across four farms between Quairading and Kojonup. These plantings, composed of native tree species suited to the local area, were strategically placed in narrow belts and small blocks on land that was predominantly used for agricultural purposes for at least five years prior to project commencement. The reforestation effort not only delivers substantial carbon removal but also enhances biodiversity by regenerating forest canopy and supporting habitats on light sandy patches and along stream banks, contributing to ecologically regenerative outcomes in the actively farmed landscape.

## APPENDIX B: ELECTRICITY SUMMARY

There are two international best-practice methods for calculating electricity emissions – the location-based method and the market-based method. Reporting electricity emissions under both methods is called dual reporting.

Dual reporting of electricity emissions is useful, as it provides different perspectives of the emissions associated with a business's electricity usage.

Location-based method:

The location-based method provides a picture of a business's electricity emissions in the context of its location, and the emissions intensity of the electricity grid it relies on. It reflects the average emissions intensity of the electricity grid in the location (State) in which energy consumption occurs. The location-based method does not allow for any claims of renewable electricity from grid-imported electricity usage.

Market-based method:

The market-based method provides a picture of a business's electricity emissions in the context of its renewable energy investments. It reflects the emissions intensity of different electricity products, markets and investments. It uses a residual mix factor (RMF) to allow for unique claims on the zero emissions attribute of renewables without double-counting.

For this certification, electricity emissions have been set by using the **market-based approach**.
